Baisakhi It is usually celebrated on April 13 or 14 every year. It marks the Sikh new year and commemorates the formation of Khalsa panth of warriors under Guru Gobind Singh in 1699. Vaisakhi is also an ancient festival celebrating the spring harvest. Know that the origins of bhangra moves-a dance associated with the Punjab where Sikhs originate from are moves to show farmers during harvest time. The Golden Temple is the most famous Sikh temple in the world.
