### History

We are looking at the impact and legacy of the Roman Invasion in Britain. We will be looking at surviving architecture and roads and the Roman influence on Britain.

### Geography

We will continue to look at the world map with an emphasis on climate zones, biomes and the impact on animals and habitats because of the changing climate.

### Art & Design

In art the children, we will continue to further develop our sketching skills. Through studying the work of Freida Kahlo, we will be working on our own self portrait and experimenting with mixed media to create decoupage.

### Design Technology

In Design and Technology, children will be exploring mechanical systems via our unit on pneumatic toys and look at the digital world through our unit on wearable technology.



## What are we learning in year 3/4 during the Spring Term?

### Computing



In computing children will be learning about Scratch and programming and then moving onto logging data.

### PSHE/RSE



PSHE this term is all about our dreams and goals and how to be healthy. We will be looking at how we can succeed at our dreams and what we can do to ensure our bodies are healthy.

### PE

In PE this term the children will be building up their knowledge and skills within netball, dodgeball and dance linked to their history unit on the Romans.
