Attendance is compulsory. Any absence must be reported to the office before 9am. If you have any concerns or would like to discuss the return to school with a member of staff, please call the office.



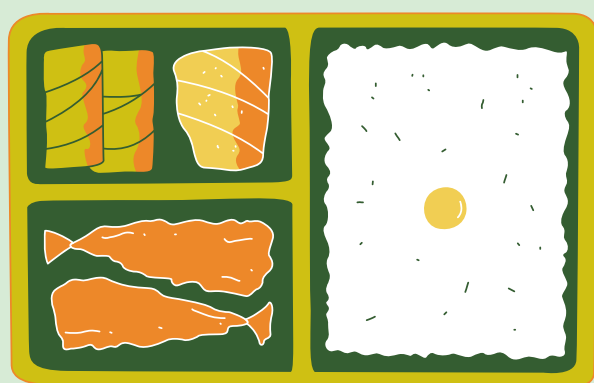
Bags
