The pupil questionnaire was given to all pupils across the school from Year 1 to Year 6.

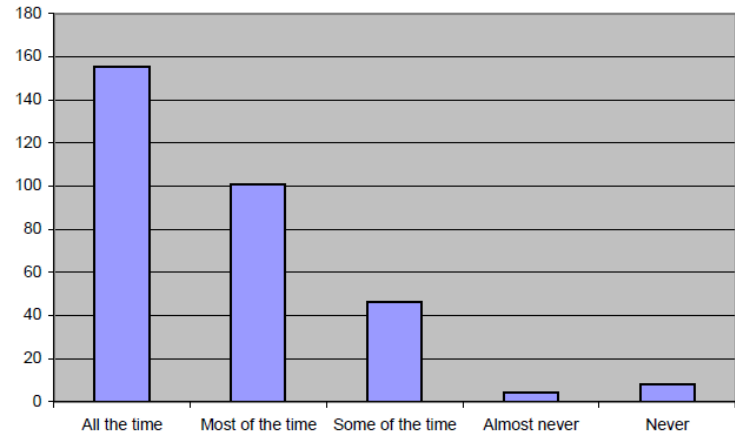
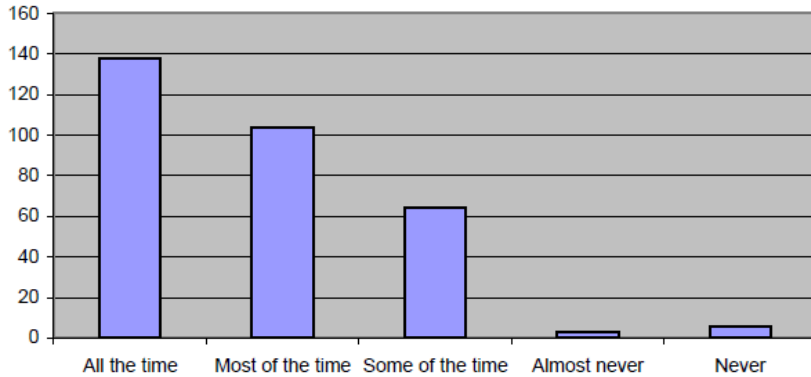
In total, 317 children responded to the questionnaire. This is the analysis for the whole school, however, the analysis has also been completed for each year group to further understand the results and responses.

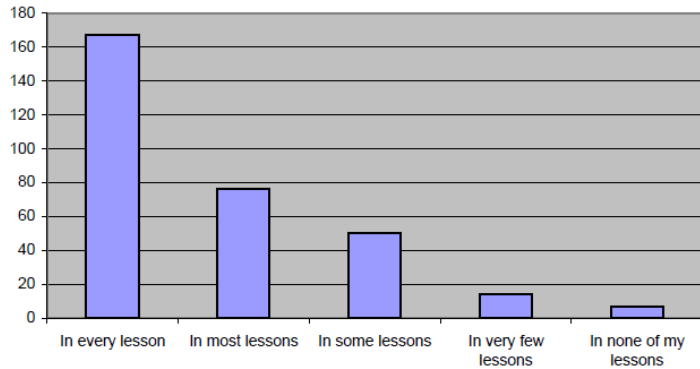


The majority of children at Herrick enjoy school and enjoy learning at school.

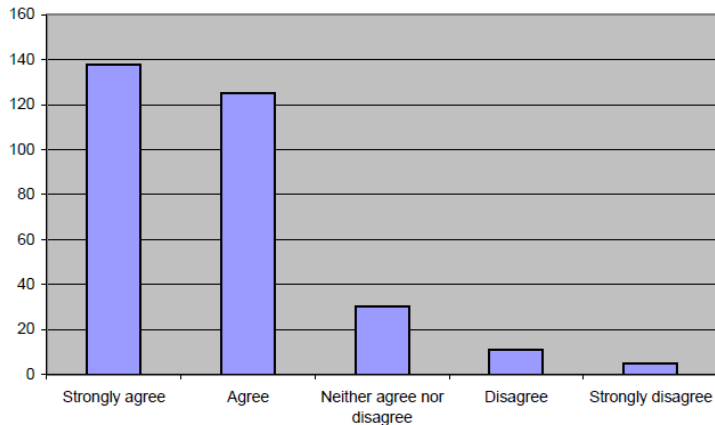

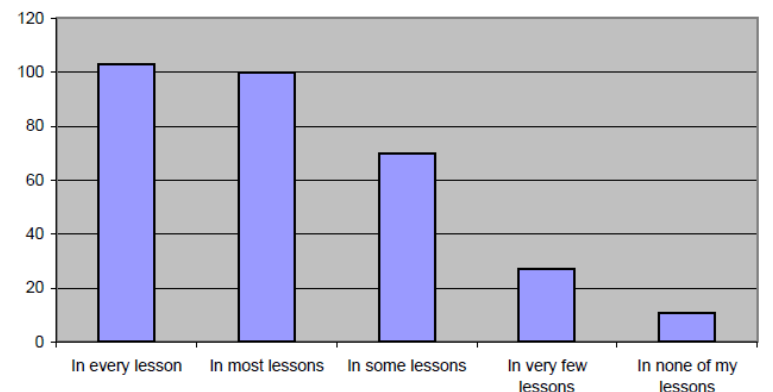
Most children at Herrick feel that the teachers respect, help and challenge them in lessons.

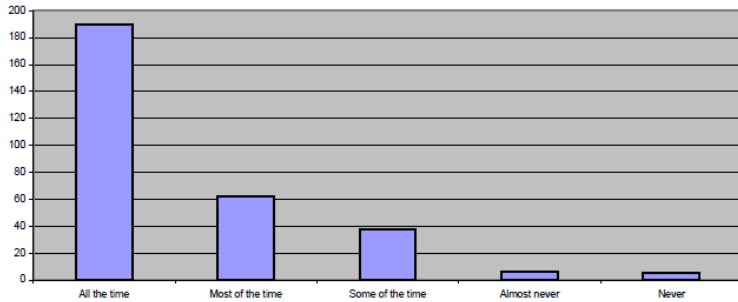

Safety and Bullying

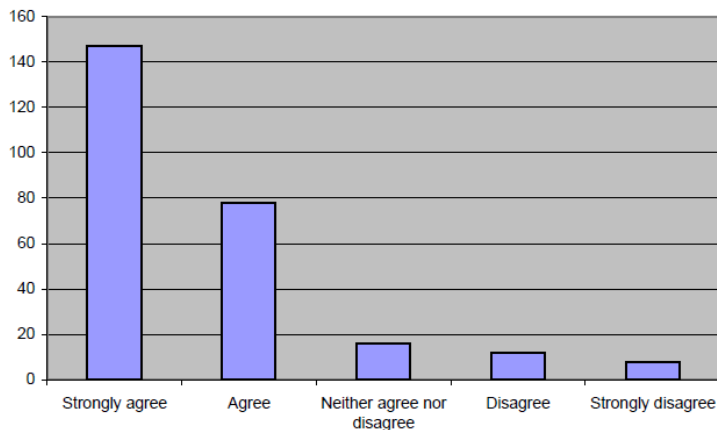

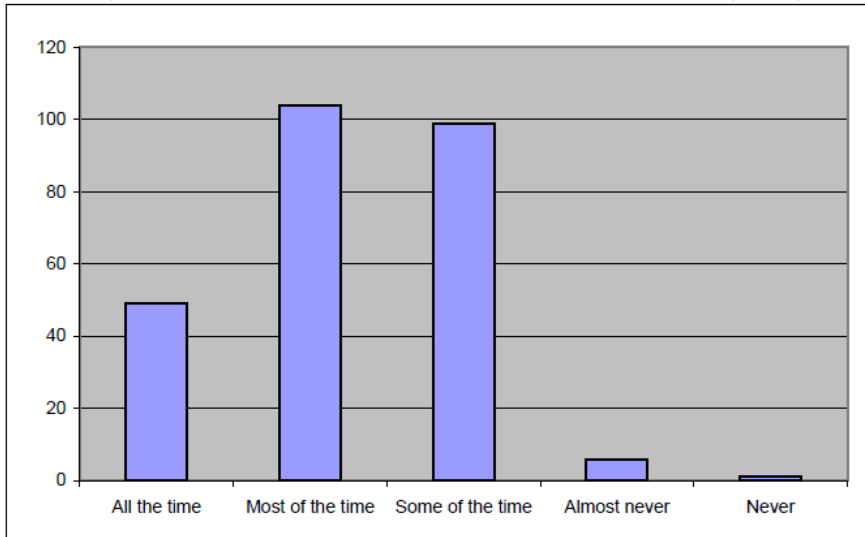

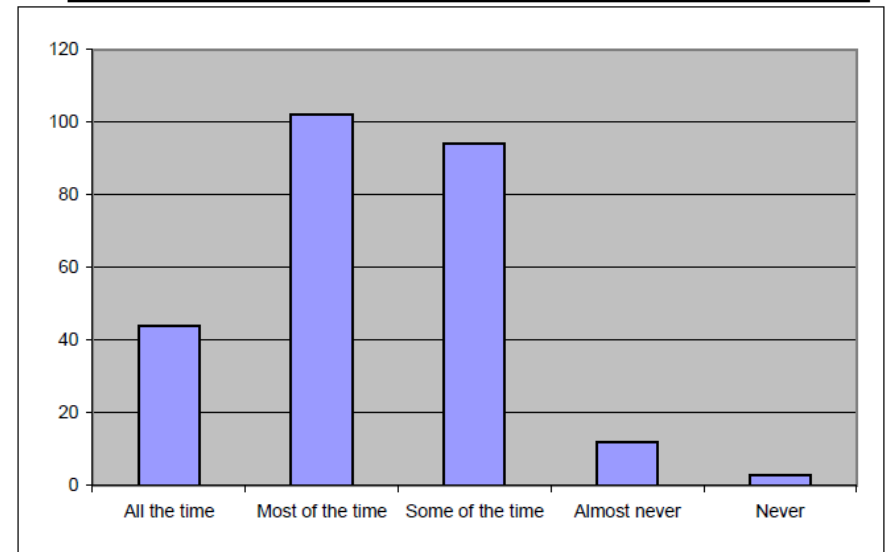

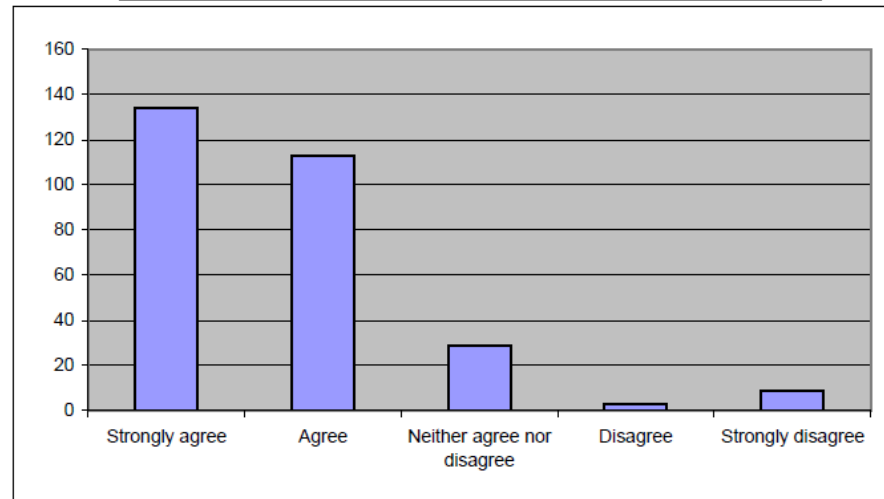
Pupils at Herrick believe that behaviour is good most of the time in lessons and around the school.

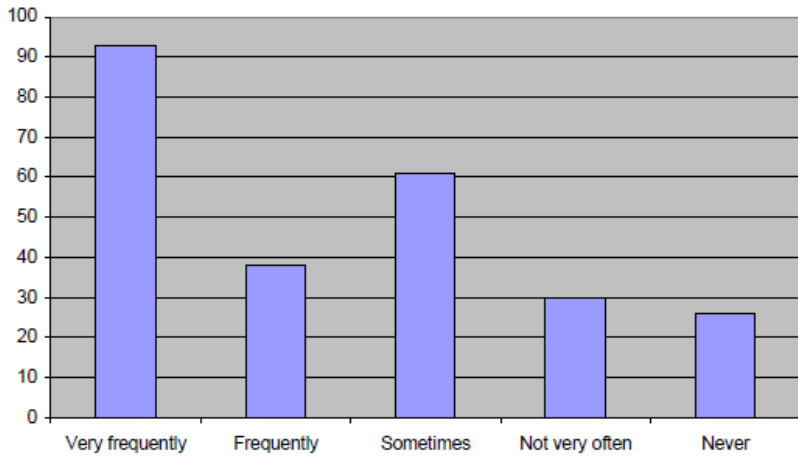


The pupils at Herrick agree strongly that as a school, Herrick encourages children to look after their physical, mental and emotional health.

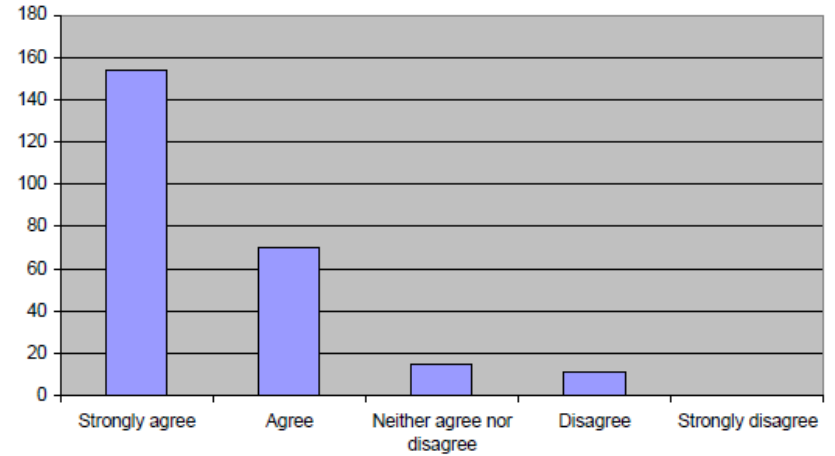

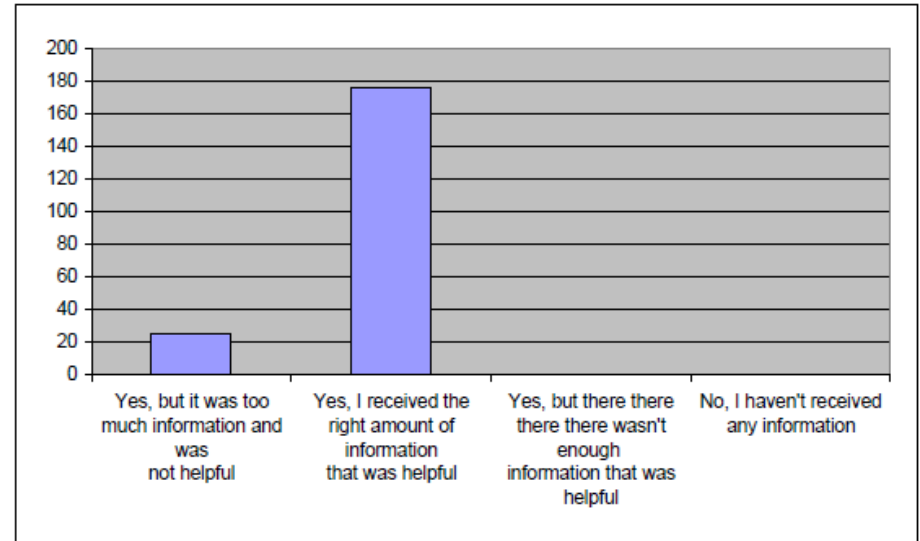
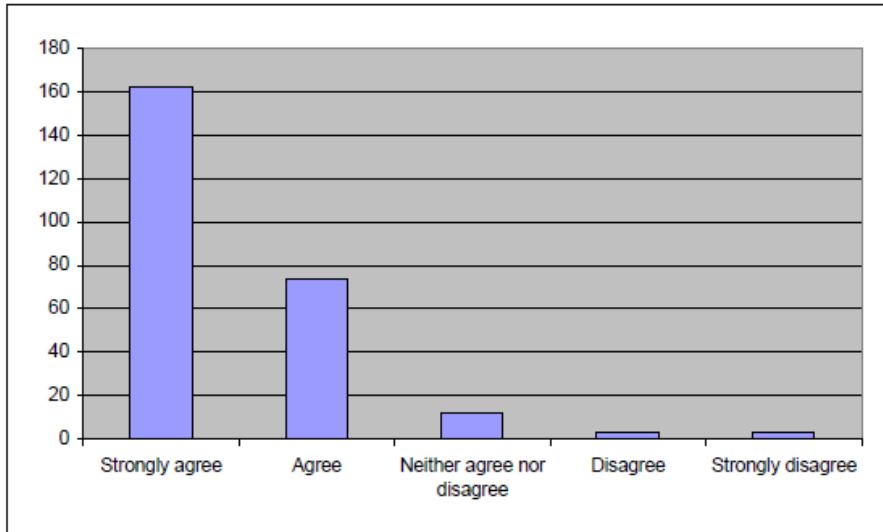


Most children at Herrick take part in activities outside of school and agree that the staff encourage the children to be independent and take on responsibilities.

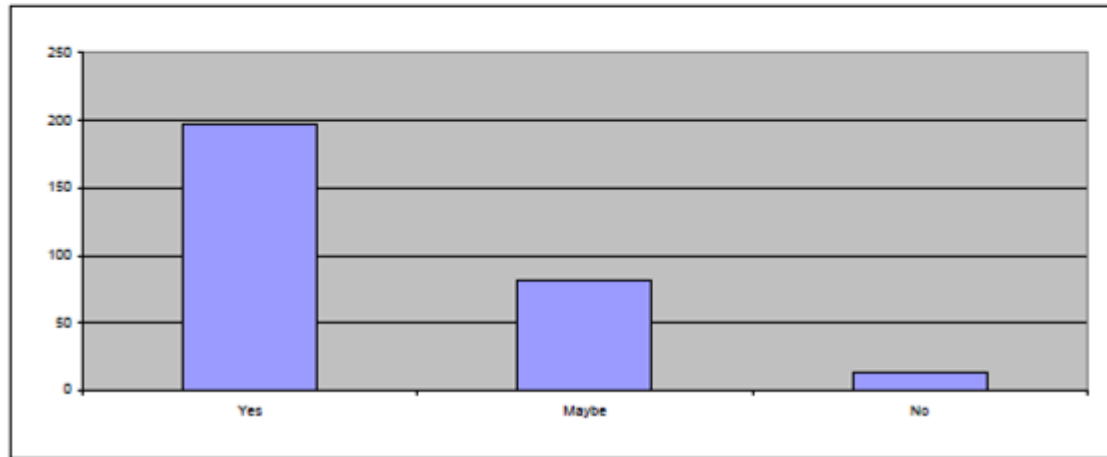
