In Design and Technology, children will be exploring Textiles using Cross-stitch applique and Egyptian collar and creating an Electrical poster.








What are We Learning in Year 3/4 during the Autumn Term?

<u>Science</u>



Science is a practical subject and children will work in small groups, partners and individually. Science is a combination of working like a scientist and building up knowledge and understanding. This term we will be looking at the states of matter and Habitats.
