In Design Technology, the children will be looking at mechanisms and using pulleys and gears.








What are We Learning in Year 5 during the Autumn Term?

Computing



PSHE/RSE



Being Me in My World if the first topic the children will cover in PSHE. They will learn all about goals and dreams and how to create effective target. They will use the British values to help learn about being global citizens and learn their rights and responsibilities within the world.

PE

In PE this term the children will be working with on their hockey skills and learning to use their equipment safely. They will also be looking at working as a team.



Science



Science is a practical subject and children will work in small groups, partners and individually. Science is a combination of working like a scientist and building up knowledge and understanding. This term we will be looking at the properties of material and how states of matters can change as well as how to separate mixtures effectively.

French

This term in French we will be learning all about using nouns and adjective to create sentences. The sentences will be about imaginary monsters.

Music



In music this term the children are learning all about beats and rhythms. Thy are focussing on the tune of 'Livin on a Prayer' and using Glockenspiels.

Religious Education

In RE, we will be learning all about concepts of welcoming new life into the world and how people can show commitment to religion. Pupils will focus on Judaism, Christianity and Hinduism and compare different beliefs.
