



Topic

History

In History, the children will be learning all about the Second World War. They will explore the ideology of Adolf Hitler and the reasons that Neville Chamberlain declared war on Germany. They will also examine the effect of the Blitz and how British people adapted during the war. In the second half term, the consequences of the war will be investigated and children will learn about key events post-war.

Art & Design

In art children will study and create vintage movie posters focusing on how to use 3D letters and laying to create an effective composition. Following this, pupils will study art movements, such as impressionism and cubism and discuss how and why these artworks became well-known.

Design Technology

In DT, children will design and present information about a product to help with navigation and travel. Pupils will be able to use 'Tinkercad' (an online design tool) to achieve this.







What are We Learning in Year 6 during the Autumn Term?

Computing



In computing this term, we are looking at Computer systems, networks, communication and collaboration. The children will learn all about the most effective ways to share work and collaborate with others. They will also learn about how data is transferred across the internet and websites are made.

PSHE/RSE



Being Me is the first topic the children will cover in PSHE. They will discuss their own personal goals and how to achieve them. They will also learn about bring a role model and what democracy means. Celebrating Differences will look at how every individual is different and how everyone should be respected.

PE

In PE this term the children will be working on passing, movement and teamwork in football. In rugby, pupils will learn the rules of how to move the ball forward up the field as well as the correct techniques to pass the ball.

Science



Science this term begins with how scientists such as Carl Linnaeus and Charles Darwin classified living things, including microorganisms. Children will learn how to ask questions and use Venn diagrams to find similarities and differences between living things. Following this, children will learn how animals and plants have adapted to their environment or habitat and why organisms may become extinct.

French



This term in French we will learn to how speak and respond to questions about sports and the Olympics. They will learn vocabulary, including prepositions and verbs, to discuss sports in French.

Music



In music this term the children will learn to listen and appraise music as well as practicing singing in unison to backing music. They will also create a simple melody with at least 5 notes and basic rhythm ending in a performance.

Religious Education

In RE, we will learn how different beliefs feel about the existence of God, concepts of 'evil', right and wrong and how we contribute to world peace. Students will link creation stories to create their own personal world view.
