# Evidence me

- Activities will be set up around the classroom to accommodate for your child's learning from the EYFS curriculum.
- 'Evidence me' captures photos/videos of your child working towards a target for example; making a repeated pattern with the peg boards.
- Once captured, the evidence is then stored for next targets and progress.
- At the end of each half term an observation of your child will be sent to parents to witness the hard work but also fun your child experiences at nursery <sup>(i)</sup>
