Dear Parents/Carers,

Sending these books home will help parents/carers get a clearer view of the work carried out in lessons. It is crucial that parents/carers recognise that the core purpose behind this initiative is to support **discussion**.

You could ask –

- *Talk to me about this piece of work*
- *Explain how you did this*
- *Show me your best piece of work. Why?*
- *What do you find difficult? Why?*

Ways parents/carers can get involved in supporting children’s learning:

Learning at home: We recognise that parents/carers are the first and ongoing educators of their own children and, as such, should receive information and support to help develop their child’s learning at home, in the community and at school.

Home/School partnership: We encourage the involvement of parents/carers in the work we do and continually look at ways of providing information that helps you to engage with us and your child’s education.

Parental representation: We want to ensure that parents/carers have the opportunity to express their views and have these taken into account when determining how best to support your child.

Please read and review the books and **return them to school the next day**. As your children use these books every day, they **must** be returned to school the following morning. The information in these books is used to help us create a true assessment of your child’s progress. If they are not returned then we will be unable to provide accurate information. We would also advise you, that if these books are lost then books will not be sent home in the future.

Please complete the slip below if you would like work books to be sent home. By consenting to receive the books at home you are taking responsibility for ensuring the books are returned the following day.
